

How do I proceed towards a bachelor's degree?

If you have <u>no</u> prior knowledge of Chinese language, please check the following table:

Term 1

Chinese I Course package: (for true beginners)

Chinese in Speech and Writing I, 15 Credits Chinese Oral Proficiency I, 7.5 Credits Chinese Characters I, 7.5 Credits

Complete course package I or minimum 30 credits

Term 2

Complete course package II or minimum 30 credits

Complete course package III or minimum 30 credits

Term 4 & Term 5

- A. Chinese in Speech and Writing IV, 15 Credits
- B. Languages, Literature and Culture
 -Research Methodology and Academic Writing, 7.5 Credits (Autumn)
- C. Chinese Modern Literature I, 7.5 Credits (Autumn)
- D. Chinese Linguistics, 7.5 Credits (Autumn)
- E. Chinese: Language Learning and Teaching, 7.5 Credits (Spring)
- F. Chinese: Chinese Society, 7.5 Credits (Spring)

Total 165 credits, 90 credits of Chinese which must include course A and course B, and 3 courses from course C to course F.

Term 6

Chinese: Bachelor Degree Thesis, 15 Credits (Spring)

Note:

- 1. It is students' responsibility to apply for courses or course packages every term via antagning.se or universityadmissions.se.
- 2. Students can study part-time towards a BA degree in Chinese. However, courses in the first 60 credits have evening seminars, all other courses only have day-time seminars.
- 3. There are a few additional courses offered at various levels, please check https://www.du.se/chinese for the full list of courses.
- If you have prior knowledge of Chinese language, you should have your knowledge assessed to apply for courses that fit your Chinese proficiency level.

Documentation for previous studies

If you have documentation (transcript and/or certificate) for Chinese courses studied outside Sweden, please submit the documentation when applying for courses via antagning.se or universityadmissions.se.

Placement test

If you have NO documentation for your prior knowledge of Chinese, you can complete an online placement test with us. Please contact amne.kinesiska@du.se about the placement test. However, all students who plan to apply for the BA thesis course must fulfil the course prerequisites.

Transfer of Credit for Previous Studies

If you want to use the credits that you have received at other higher education institutions abroad to fulfill the requirement of BA thesis course, you can apply for credit transfer at Dalarna University after you become a registered student at Dalarna University.
