

Teacher Support for Communicating the Use of AI in Assignments

Generative AI refers to any of the thousands of Artificial Intelligence tools in which the model generates new content (text, images, audio, video, code, etc.) This includes, but is not limited to, Large Language Models/ LLMs such as ChatGPT, Google Bard, etc.; Image creators such as Dall-E3, Adobe Firefly; and any tools with built in generative AI capabilities such as Microsoft CoPilot, Google Duet, Canva, etc.)
